# WHO IS WSTA?

The Winston-Salem Transit Authority (WSTA) was established in 1972 to provide public transportation services to the residents of Winston-Salem, North Carolina.

Over the years, WSTA has expanded its services to include paratransit and other amenities.

Today, WSTA operates a large fleet and serves a considerable number of passengers on a daily basis.

In 2024, the City of Winston-Salem voted to approve a contract with RATP Dev USA to begin operating the Winston-Salem Transit Authority's bus system. Service under the new contract began August 1, 2024.

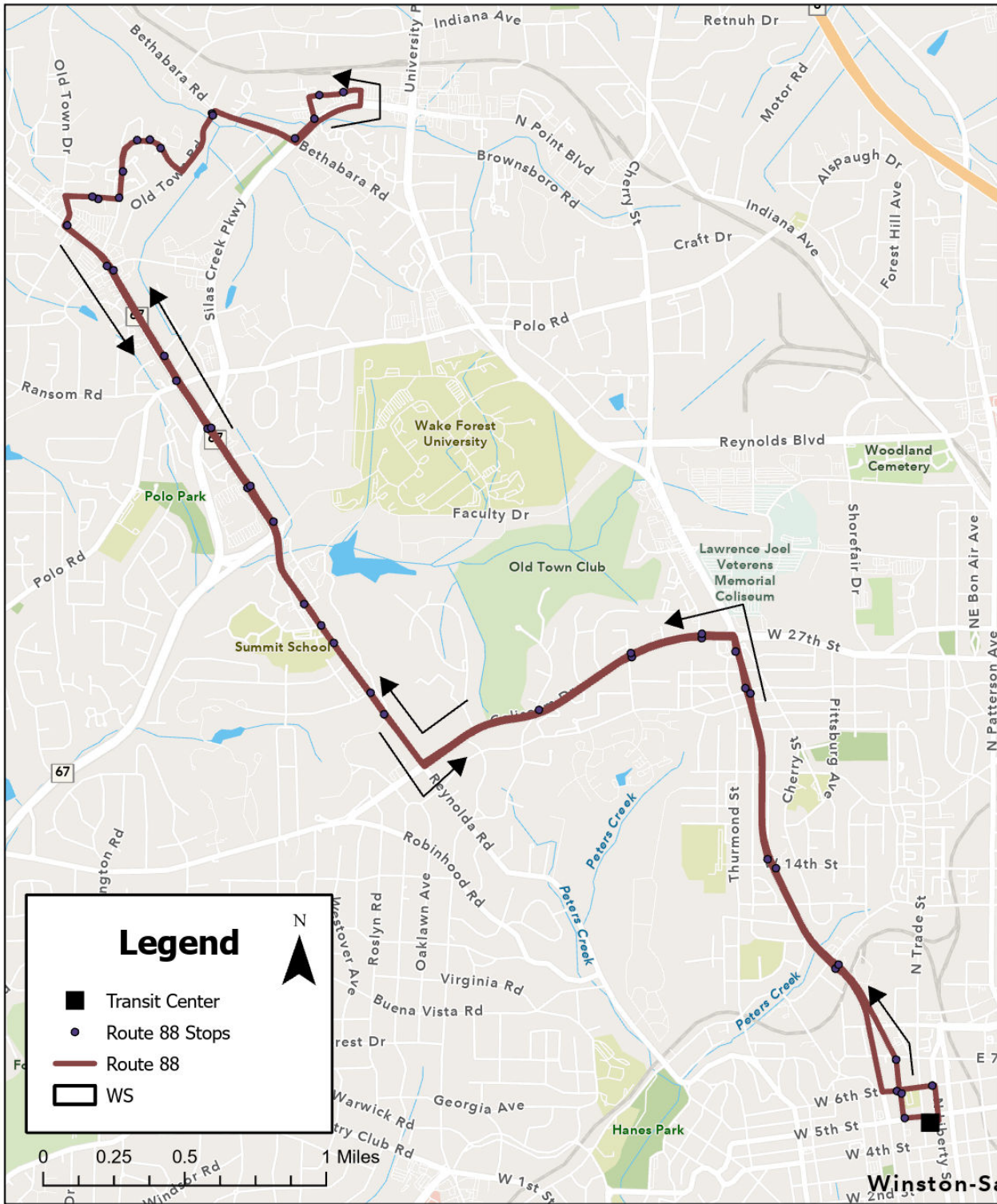
