**ROUTE 110 ALTERNATIVES** 

### DO YOU CURRENTLY USE A ROUTE THAT MAY BE ELIMINATED OR CHANGED?

Routes 99, 100, and 110 are currently being eliminated due to low ridership, carrying fewer than 3 riders per hour on average. They were identified in a survey of WSTA drivers as well as in our study of WSTA's system as some of the routes with the fewest riders.

## These routes are proposed to be eliminated in early 2025.

To best serve the public, the hours from these eliminated routes will be added to routes that have more riders and need more service.

Routes 86, 94, 96 and 105 are available alternatives to Route 110. Riders who use Route 110 can access the following WSTA Routes along the following streets:

Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive – can use Routes 86 and 105

Service along the following streets will no longer be provided:

5th Street from Maryland Avenue to Lowery Court

**The Lowery Street facility** will no longer be served by WSTA.
